The planning group is admirably persistent and has submitted plans for an initial development, a middle of the road Christian school, which will grow as demand grows. As with most developments of this type funding is an issue particularly when the implications of a site adjacent to the McIvor Highway are considered.

Chris Corr, Vice President of the Bendigo Sustainability Group reported on the many Community Scale Projects such as the 20Kw solar panel project supplying electricity to the Bendigo Library and the similar contributions to the work of the Bendigo Tramways, the Discovery Centre and the Archive Centre. The great news is the selection of BSG to manage one of the three Community Power Hubs in Victoria. There is a great opportunity for JCAG to get involved in the project over the next couple of years. The development of a hydro scheme in the many mine shafts under Bendigo is a particularly exciting possibility. We will be following these possibilities vigorously and would appreciate feedback from the community.
